In other words, it's your turn! With Maastricht Citizen Budget, you and other residents decide how to spend £€,750,000. In 2025, choose from 5 themes:



Artistic and cultural activities stimulate creativity, participation and encounters between residents.

Think of neighbourhood art, workshops, exhibitions and art projects. Or performances in squares, schools or care homes. Art and culture stimulate your mind, allow you to see things differently and make you happy. Can you tell us how your idea will help make Maastricht even more culturally vibrant?

Getting along well with others is important in our lives. How wonderful it is when you can do something for someone else. Think, for example, of organising activities to bring people from a neighbourhood together. Or placing exchange boxes where local residents can share non-perishable products with each other.

What ideas do you have for a society in which everyone counts and is valued?

A green environment is good for your health and reduces heat and water damage. To make a neighbourhood greener, you could create pick-your-own gardens or façade gardens. Bee hotels or extra trees can be installed. Perhaps plants or flowers could be added to parking spaces. How would you like to make Maastricht greener and contribute to the happiness and health of people and animals?

Submit a project for a maximum of £€ £45,000.

Don't just think about playgrounds for the little ones. Think about sporting activities for young people too.

Or associations for the neighbourhood, the elderly or another specific group. Foundations and unofficial associations or clubs can submit their ideas under another theme. How can your association make Maastricht stronger,

more social or more creative?
